Numeracy

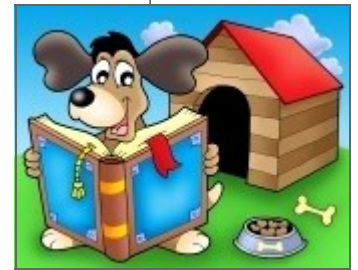
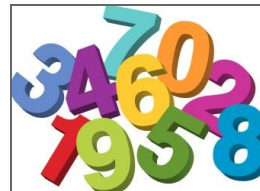
We have been talking about patterns and 2D shapes. When you are out at the week-end see if your child
