of the letters and sounds we have been learning so far. We will also be writing simple words focusing on hearing the beginning, middle and end sounds in each word.

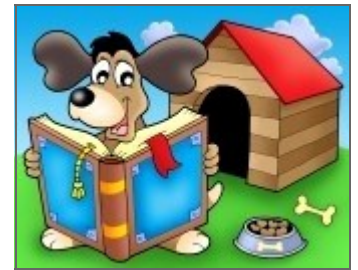

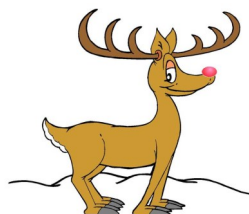
Please join us for a mince pie and a glass of mulled wine at our Open Afternoon this coming Friday.
